year at a glance

During the 2022-2023 school year, Bite2Go supported over 1,550 middle and high school students through the Bite2GoXL program, along with more than 7,750 kids across the greater Bite2Go service area.

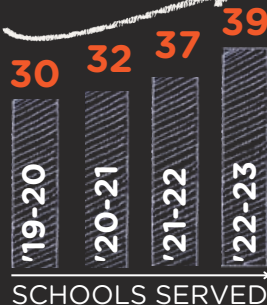
Two brand new Spokane-area secondary schools - Flett and Yasuhara Middle Schools - joined the program this past year. We expect another school to join us in the 2023-2024 school year as Spokane District 81 opens a new middle school, Peperzak, in the fall. Food costs also drove increased enrollment; higher inflation brought higher rates of food insecurity for many families in our community.

In this time of greater need, we are especially thankful for the generosity of sponsors, including the churches, businesses, clubs, and individuals who helped to provide weekend food relief to kids facing chronic food shortages at home. Our donors and program partners help to get kids the nutrition they need over the weekend so they come to school ready to learn on Monday morning.

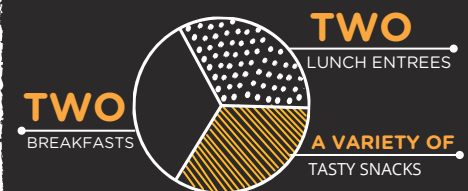
